Moving Toward the Future

Reopening Dental:

On Monday June 1st, the Warsaw dental team completed scenario testing, and that afternoon the hygienist seen two patients and Dr. Currey seen four patients on Tuesday. In-person visits are going well, the hope is to have 6 patients scheduled per day.

This week in Sedalia there will be one hygienist and one dentist in clinic. These providers will be seeing emergency patients. The goal is to increase the number of encounters to 8 patients per day in two weeks, however this is dependent upon PPE. Currently, Sedalia dental is in the middle of a remodel to provide temporary barriers between dental operatories, the hope is to have this completed by end of the week.

Reopening Medical:

All clinics have completed scenario testing to prepare for in-person visits. Starting Monday June 8th medical will open their doors to in-person visits for non-COVID patients who pass the screening questions.

School Based Services:

Our Outreach and Enrollment Coordinator has been in contact with surrounding schools to identify how Katy Trail services can benefit their students at the start of the school year. It has been identified that behavioral health services and immunizations will be the focus.

PPE Update:

Katy Trail has been diligently ordering PPE supplies and dispersing them to outlining clinics once received. Just this week, we received 129 boxes of gloves and 4500 surgical masks which will be dispersed to all clinics along with disposable gowns this week. We are in the process of obtaining additional N95 masks and scrub jackets.

Safety:

1. Our Nursing Educator and Safety Specialist will be making rounds to all clinics to assess competency for nasopharyngeal specimen collection for all clinical staff.
