To preserve a safe environment for patients and to protect our workforce, Katy Trail is working on a stepwise approach for expanding our face-to-face medical and oral health visits. So far this week, Sedalia dental has completed one round of scenario testing which brought up several great questions. The dental team is working through these questions to establish a solid workflow, more scenario testing to come. Medical is in the process of creating a plan to provide in-person care to non-COVID patients. The screening questions are being revised to guide staff on the appropriate steps to take on whether a patient can be seen in-person or virtual only.
