Reopening Dental:

Sedalia dental completed scenario testing this week to prepare for in-person visits starting Wednesday June 3rd. Sedalia dental will see 12 patients per day starting on June 3rd with 1 dentist and 1 hygienist in clinic. These will be patients with priority dental care needs. There will be some changes coming to the dental operatories such as creating temporary walls to assist with infection control and portable air purifiers with UV lights.

Starting Monday June 1st Warsaw dental will complete scenario testing and will open their doors to in-person visits that afternoon. The dental operatories were revamped last week to provide a safe space for our patients. Warsaw dental will see a total of 6 patients per day. As of now, Dr. Currey and team will be in Warsaw every Wednesday.

Reopening Medical:

On Monday June 8th medical will open their doors to in-person visits for non-COVID patients who pass the screening questions. Prior to June 8th, all clinics will complete scenario testing to improve workflow and identify any barriers or concerns. There will be two medical providers on-site seeing 10 face-to-face encounters per day. For those patients that do not pass the screening questions or prefer virtual visits, Katy Trail will still offer this service.
