Friday April 17th, 2020 – Coronavirus Update **Please note anything highlighted in yellow is new information**

Goal 1: Keep employees healthy and safe

- A. It is our goal to ensure that we have enough PPE supplies to sustain operations. We are continually trying to order PPE for all sites, however many items are on backorder. Below is a breakdown for each site of how many days' we could sustain testing for COVID and seeing emergent dental patients.
- B. Total Number of PPE and Test Supply Available Per Site:
 - i. Dental-Sedalia:
 1. 4 day supply of PPE
 2. Item Needed: N95 mask
 - ii. Dental-Warsaw:
 1. Will have update on Monday.
 - iii. Marshall:
 1. 25 day supply of PPE
 2. Quest Test: 3
 3. LabCorp Test: 8
 4. GeneTrait Test: 60
 5. Item Needed: N95 mask
 - iv. Sedalia:
 1. 27 day supply of PPE
 2. Quest Test: 12
 3. LabCorp Test: 19
 4. GeneTrait Test: 188
 5. Item Needed: Gowns
 - v. Versailles:
 1. 34 day supply of PPE
 2. Quest Test: 20
 3. LabCorp Test: 6
 4. GeneTrait Test: 102
 5. Item Needed: N95 mask
 - vi. Warsaw:
 1. 47 day supply of PPE – Will be distributing supplies on Monday to other clinics in need.
 2. Quest Test: 4
 3. LabCorp Test: 11
 4. GeneTrait Test: 57
 5. Item Needed: N95 mask

Goal 2: Keep possible COVID-19 patients from spreading illness to the community

- A. When calling patients regarding negative COVID-19 test results. Please address if their symptoms are getting better, the same, or worsening. If patient states their symptoms are the same or getting worse please notify the provider and an appointment may be needed.
 - a. COVID-19 test sensitivity is not 100%. It is important to address their symptoms and determine if further action is needed.

Goal 3: Continue to provide high quality of care to our patients and our communities patients by using science to guide prevention, testing, and treatment

- A. Number of patients seen during the community testing hours:
 - a. Marshal: 0 test completed
 - b. Sedalia: 3 individuals tested
 - c. Versailles: 2 individuals tested
 - d. Warsaw: 0 test completed

Goal 4: Contribute to the community efforts to address the crisis

- A. Handing out food boxes to Katy Trail patients that we test for COVID-19 and are quarantined
- B. Reaching out to food pantries in other counties and seeing how we can assist them
- C. Participating daily in the Incident Command Meeting

Goal 5: Assure our financial security in order to sustain our services

- A. Small Business Loan – Katy Trail has been approved.

- 1. Schedule Change: Currently scheduling 4 appointments per day. The times are 8:00, 10:00, 1:00, and 3:00. A dentist and dental assistant will be on site each day.
- 2. The goal is to have the virtual office up and going by late next week.

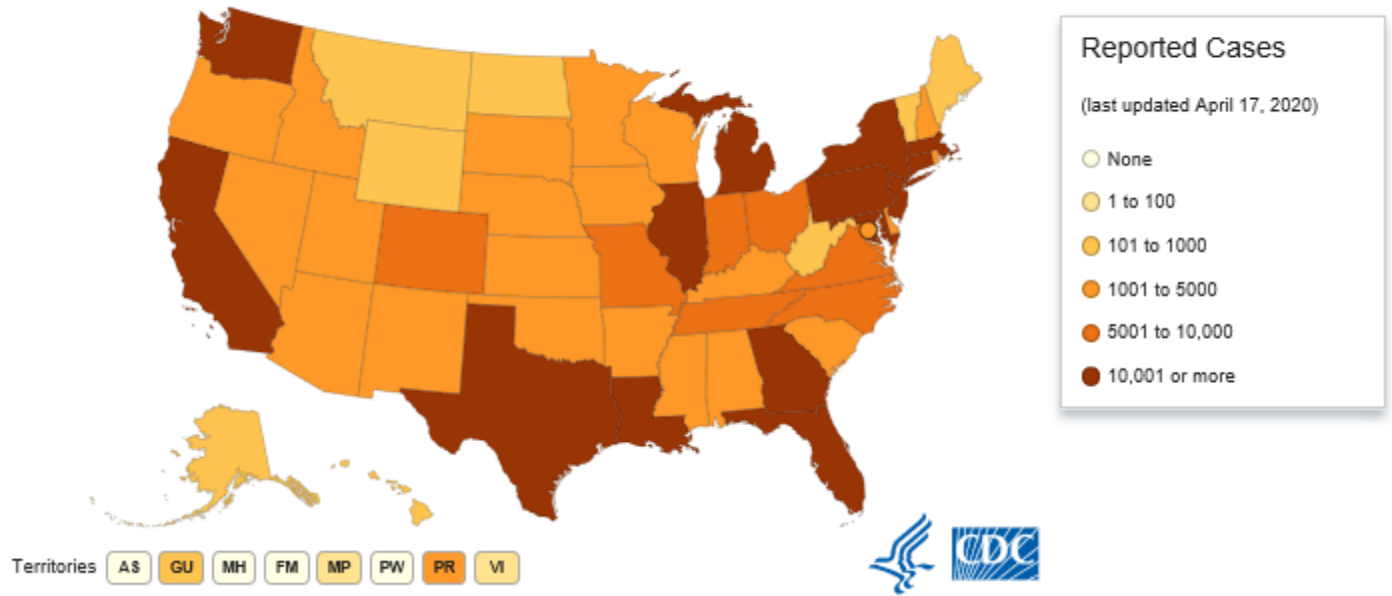

- 1. **Cases Reported in U.S.**
 - a. As of today, there has been a total of 661,712 COVID-19 cases in the United States. Please see map below of states reporting COVID-19 cases.
