## Tuesday April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020 – Coronavirus Update **Please note anything highlighted in yellow is new information**

### Goal 1: Keep employees healthy and safe

- A. Marshall, Sedalia, and Warsaw have received N95 masks! These are being collected and distributed to other clinics. Dental will be received 300 N95 masks on Thursday!
- B. Total Number of PPE and Test Supply Available Per Site:
  - i. Dental-Sedalia:
    - 1. 3 day supply of PPE
    - 2. Item Needed: N95 mask
  - ii. Dental-Warsaw:
    - 1. 1 day supply of PPE
    - 2. Item Needed: Gowns, N95, Face Shields, Gloves
  - iii. Marshall:
    - 1. 49 day supply of PPE
    - 2. Quest Test: 4
    - 3. LabCorp Test: 8
    - 4. GeneTrait Test: 59
  - iv. Sedalia:
    - 1. 33 day supply of PPE
    - 2. Quest Test: 12
    - 3. LabCorp Test: 16
    - 4. GeneTrait Test: 154
  - v. Versailles:
    - 1. 30 day supply of PPE
    - 2. Quest Test: 20
    - 3. LabCorp Test: 3
    - 4. GeneTrait Test: 96
  - vi. Warsaw:
    - 1. 60 day supply of PPE
    - 2. Quest Test: 4
    - 3. LabCorp Test: 9
    - 4. GeneTrait Test: 45
- C. COVID-19 Return to Work Policy has been updated with the following:
  - a. **You must notify your supervisor immediately with the following:**
    - i. If you present to work with a fever or develop a fever throughout the day

- ii. If you develop the following symptoms: fever, shortness of breath, cough, headache, chills, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, and muscle pain
- iii. If you or a household member have been exposed to someone that is being tested for COVID-19

**Goal 2: Keep possible COVID-19 patients from spreading illness to the community**

- A. When calling patients regarding negative COVID-19 test results. Please address if there symptoms are getting better, the same, or worsening. If patient states there symptoms are the same or getting worse please notify the provider and an appointment may be needed.
  - a. COVID-19 test sensitivity is not 100%. It is important to address their symptoms and determine if further action is needed.

**Goal 3: Continue to provide high quality of care to our patients and our communities patients by using science to guide prevention, testing, and treatment**

- A. Number of patients seen today during the community testing hours:
  - a. Marshal: 0 individuals tested
  - b. Sedalia: 14 individuals tested
  - c. Versailles: 1 individuals tested
  - d. Warsaw: 4 individuals tested
- B. Katy Trail is assisting Saline County Health Department with Community testing on Tuesday and Wednesday.

**Goal 4: Contribute to the community efforts to address the crisis**

- A. Handing out food boxes to Katy Trail patients that we test for COVID-19 and are quarantined
- B. Reaching out to food pantries in other counties and seeing how we can assist them
- C. Participating daily in the Incident Command Meeting
- D. Katy Trail Community Health is providing courier services for BRHC to St. Luke’s lab in Lees Summit 7 days/week

**Goal 5: Assure our financial security in order to sustain our services**

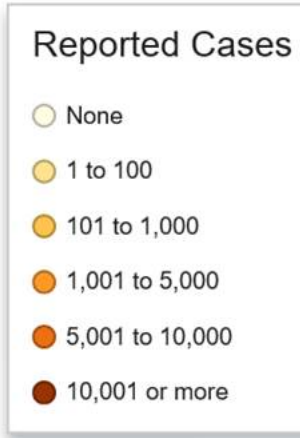
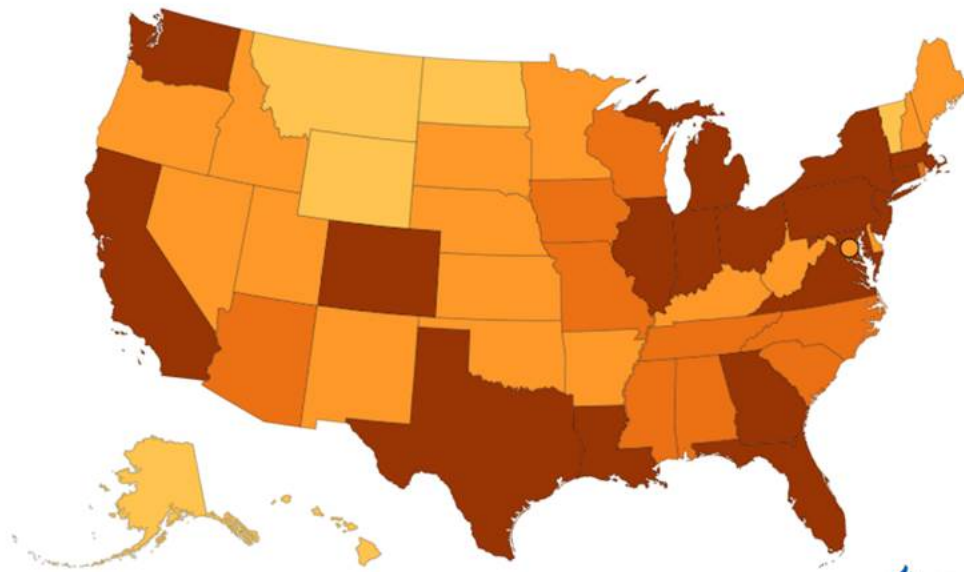
- A. Small Business Loan – Katy Trail has been approved.

  - a. As of today, there has been a total of 981,246 COVID-19 cases in the United States. Please see map below of states reporting COVID-19 cases.

  - a. 7,303 positive COVID-19 cases
    - i. Benton County – 4 positive case
    - ii. Morgan County – 3 positive case
    - iii. Pettis County – 31 positive case
    - iv. Saline County – 170 positive case
