

## How to Chart Incipient Lesions

Incipient lesions are a condition afflicting the teeth and should be charted as such. To chart conditions on teeth please follow these steps:

Indicate which teeth have this condition by clicking on them:



Make sure you have your “Entry Status” set to “Condition”:

- Condition Cn


Under the “Procedures” area select the “Conditions” tab, then click on “Incipient Caries”:
