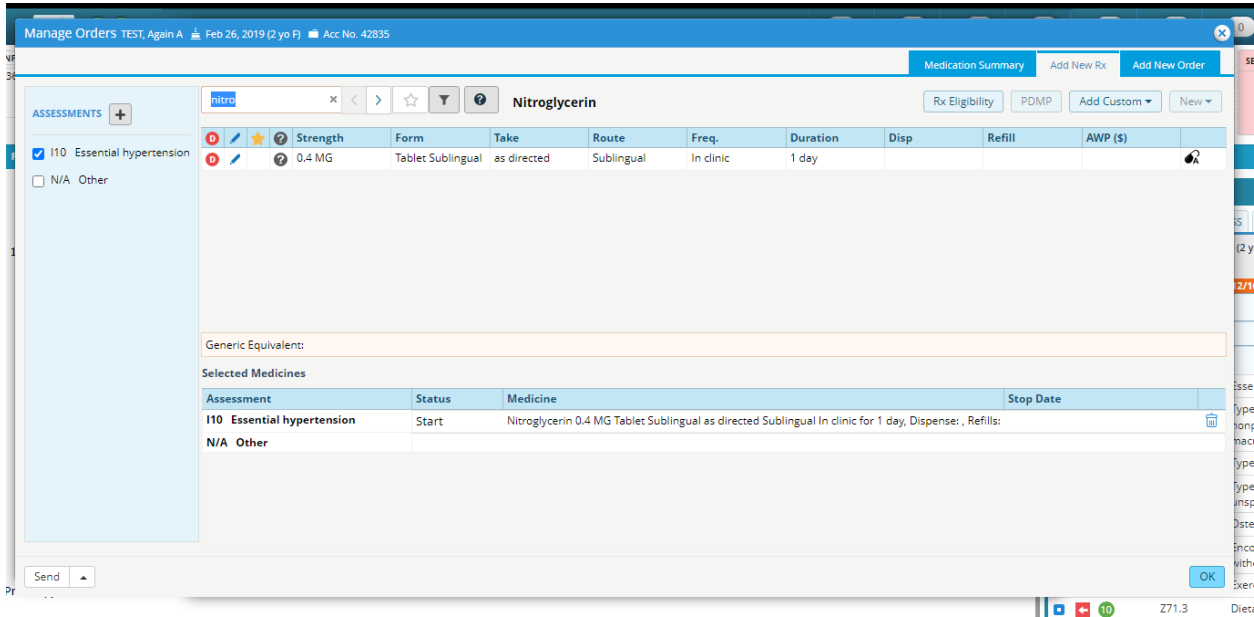
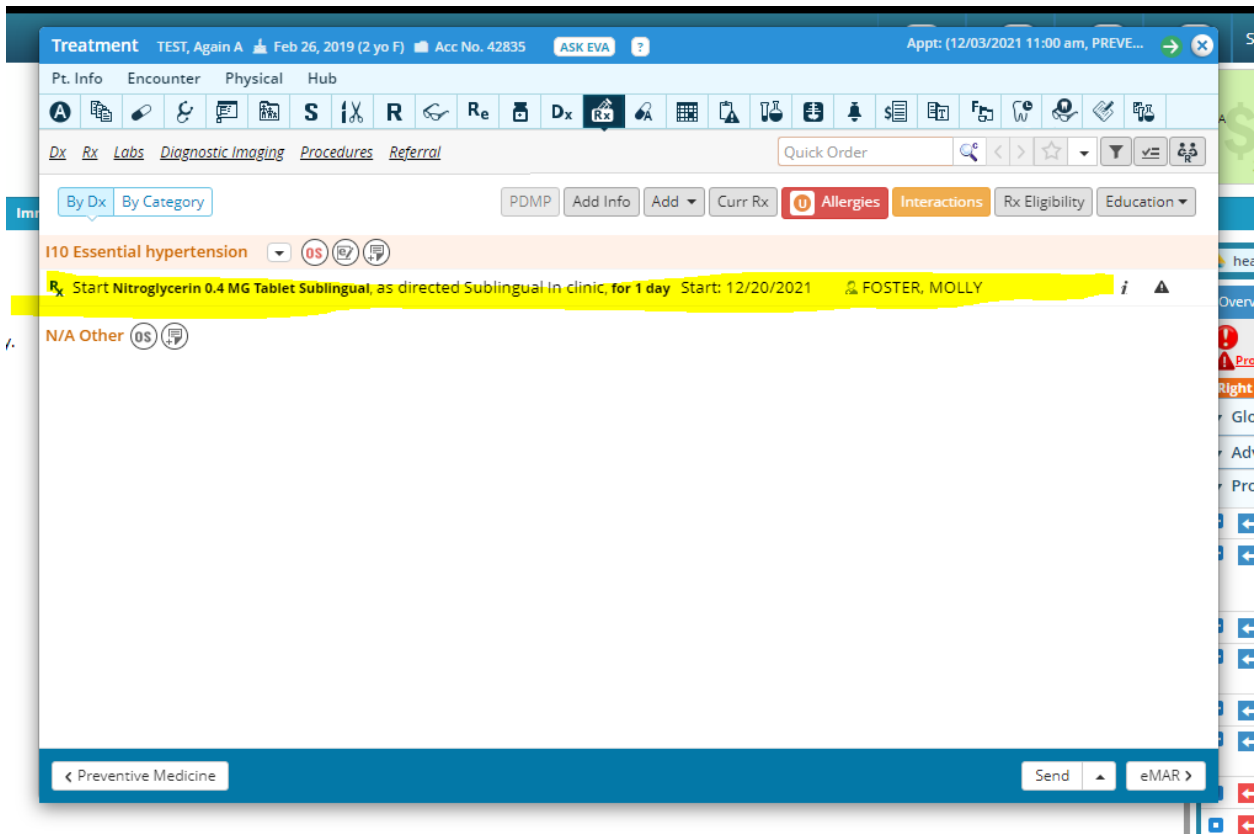


HOW TO- Administering Medication in Clinic

1. Medication to administered will be ordered. Treatment>RX> Select DX > Search Medication > Select desired medication > Click OK




2. Click on Medication ordered in treatment window to open DDR window



HOW TO- Administering Medication in Clinic

- In the DDR window you will change the status from **Start** to **In-House Medication** and enter in the **LOT Number, Expiration Date, Given by and Verified by** in the **Notes** box, and then select **OK**.





HOW TO- Administering Medication in Clinic


- Add medication to the Claim- Search the medication in the CPT description and adjust the units to the appropriate amount (i.e., If you give two tablets of a medication, your units should be 2). And assign the appropriate ICD code to the CPT code you just added.
