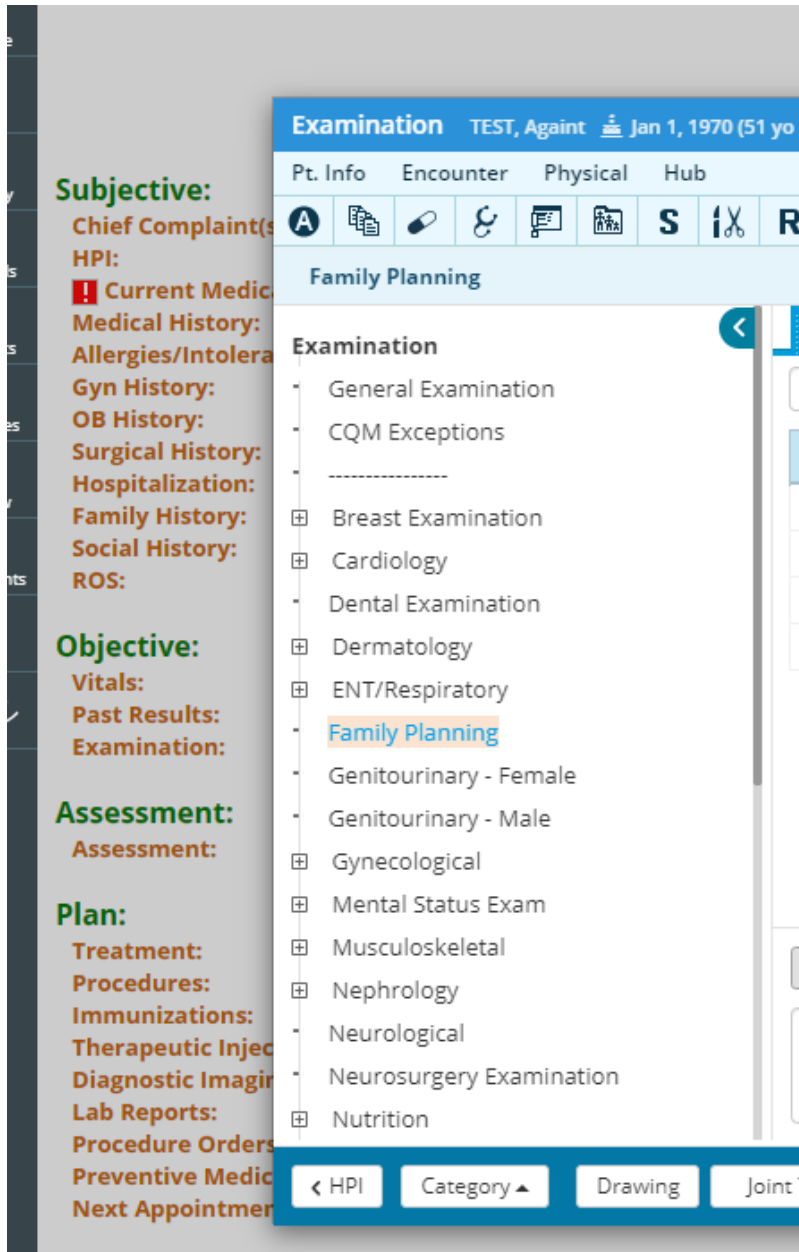


## How To Document Birth Control Method at Intake and Exit- Family Planning Visits

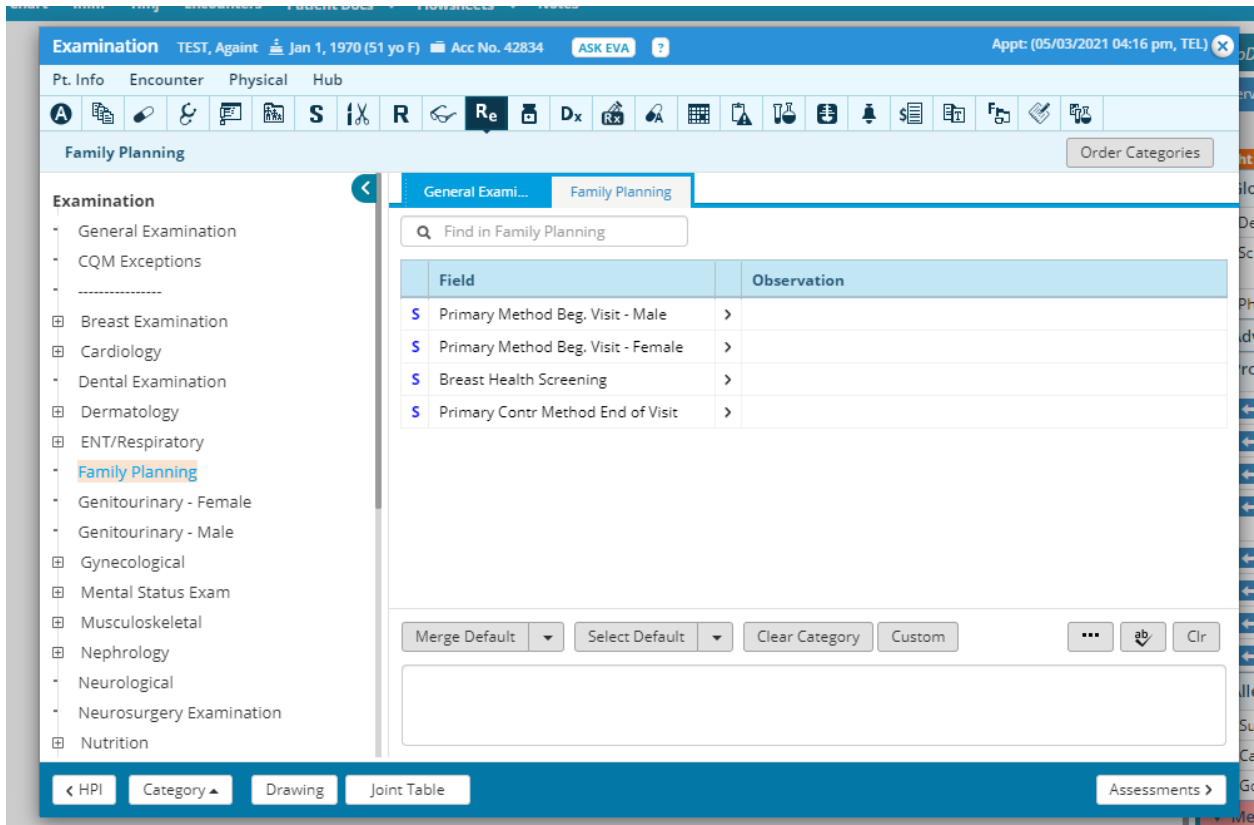
Any patient (male or female) presenting for a family planning visit must have the birth control method at intake and exit documented. This includes STI testing, birth control refill, IUD/Nexplanon insertions or removals, counseling, pregnancy testing, etc.

1. On the patient's progress note, select *Examination>Family Planning*

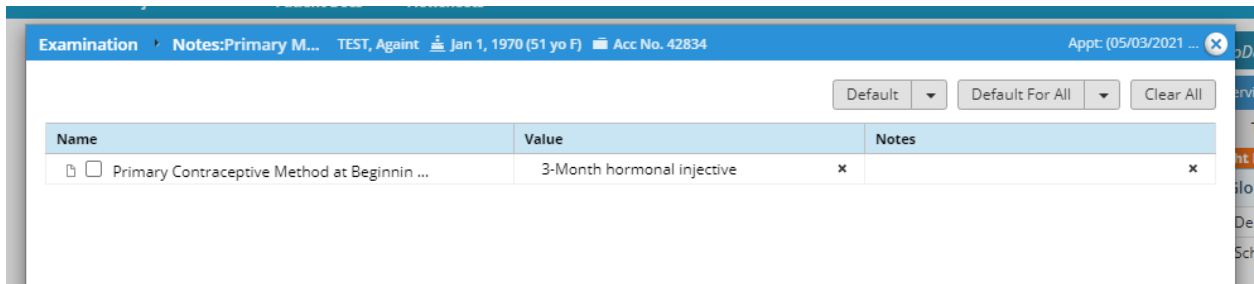


## How To Document Birth Control Method at Intake and Exit- Family Planning Visits

2. Select the *Observation* line to enter the method at the beginning of visit based on patient's gender

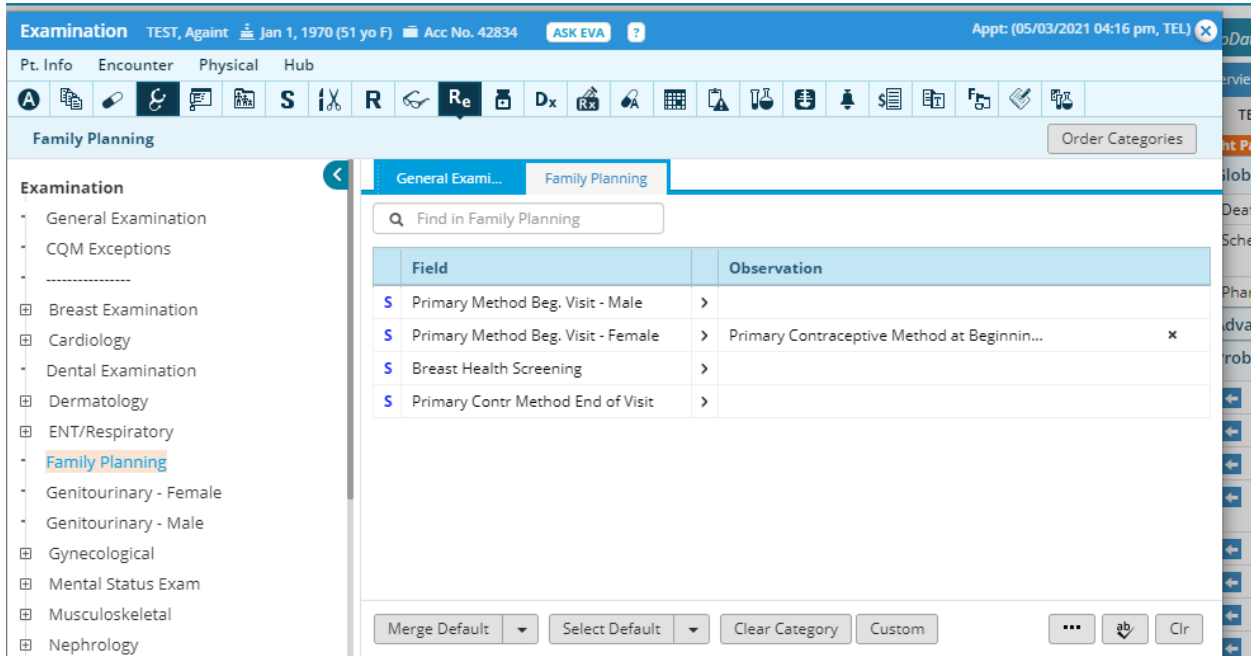


3. Select *Value* to indicate the method.
  - a. Note: Males have fewer options than females

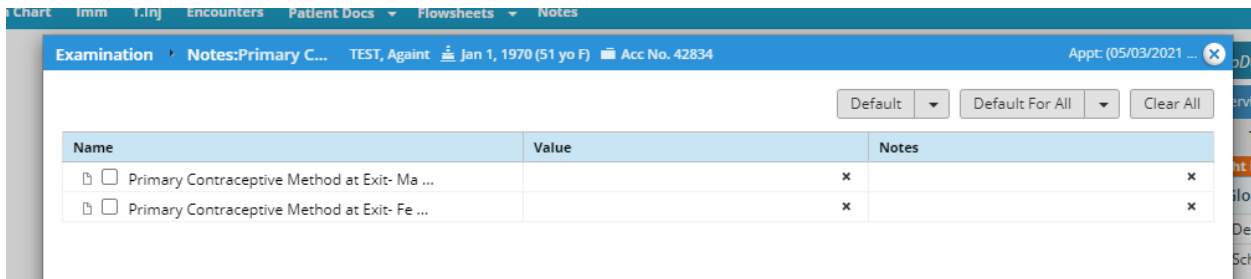


## How To Document Birth Control Method at Intake and Exit- Family Planning Visits

4. Select the *Observation* line next to *Primary Contr Method End of Visit* to enter the method that patient leaves with.



5. Select the *Value* line for the patient’s gender and then select the associated method
  - a. Note: Males have fewer options than females



6. Select “OK” to save & close

**Note:** Use of the Title X template will help with this workflow. Additionally, the Title X order set can be used to identify covered labs, immunizations, and methods.
