


How to Resolve or Edit a PHM Problem (Goal/Objective/Intervention)

To **edit** an existing problem-

1. Select the problem name (it will be underlined)





2. The problem will open with all associated goals, objectives and interventions.
3. All goals must have 1 objective & 1 intervention. They can't have more than one.
 - a. If an intervention or objective is missing click the associated goal and objective (if there is one) then click INT to add intervention. Example below. BOTH the goal and objective must be selected to enter an intervention.

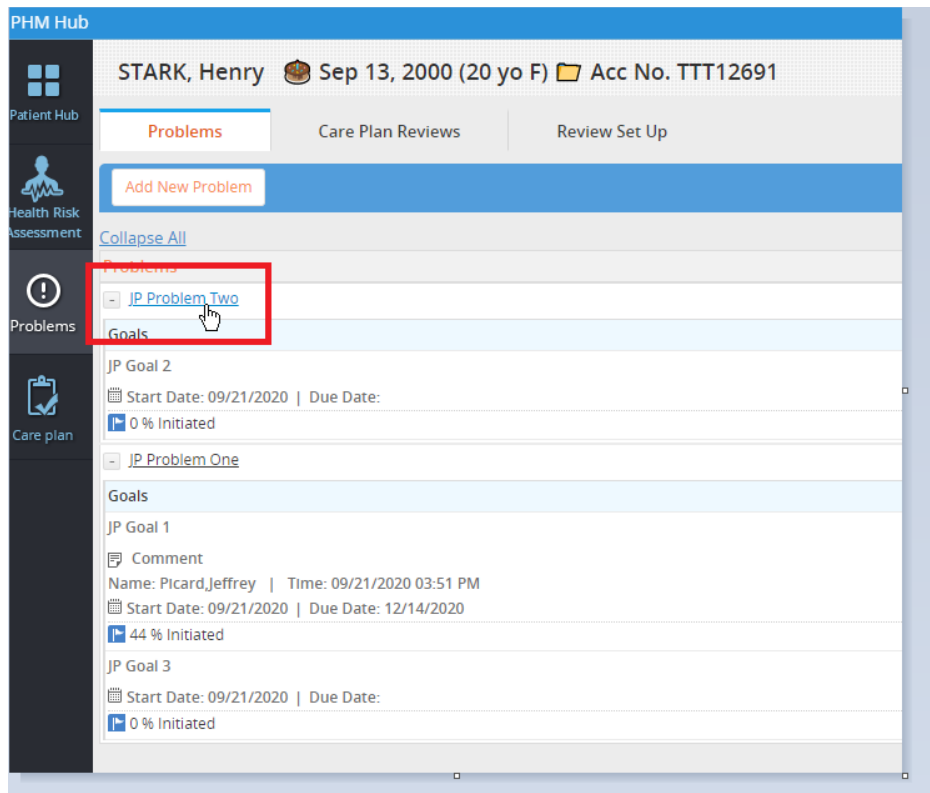

4. To enter a new goal/objective/intervention, you must enter all three new. Starting with goal then objective then intervention.
5. You can edit existing ones by selecting the blue paper icon.

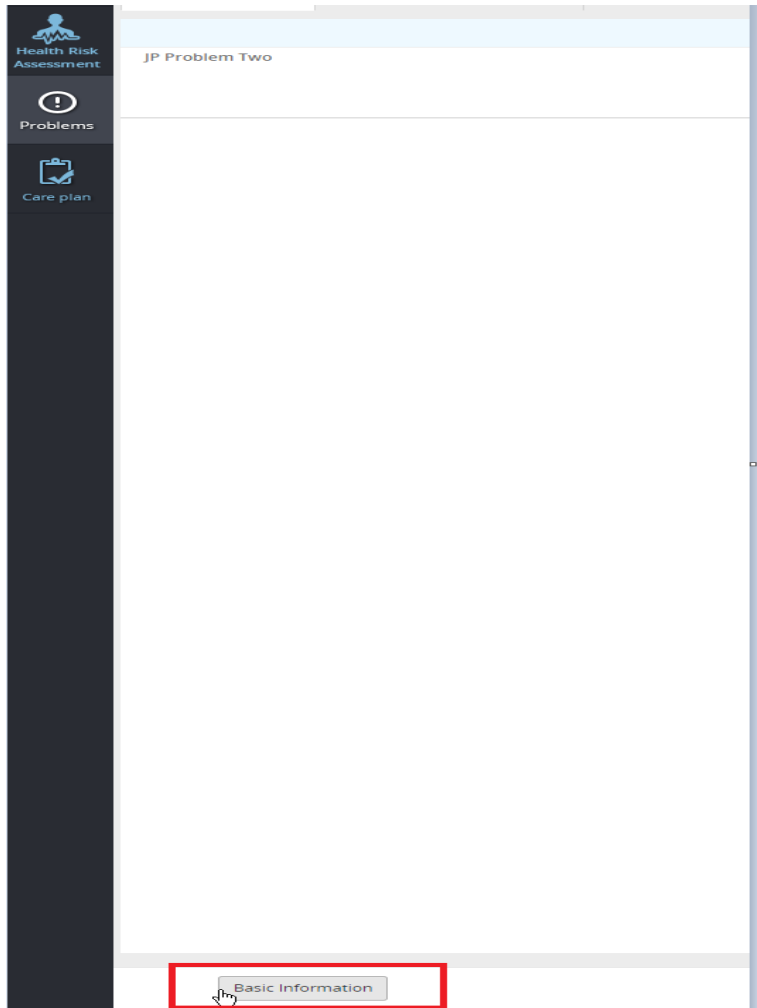
To resolve/close an existing problem-

1. To close a problem, you need to complete the additional steps once in the problem tab:




