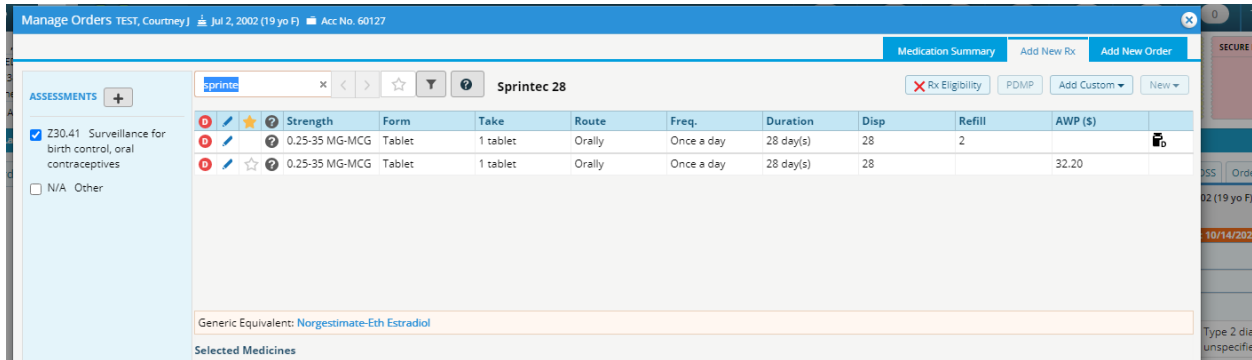
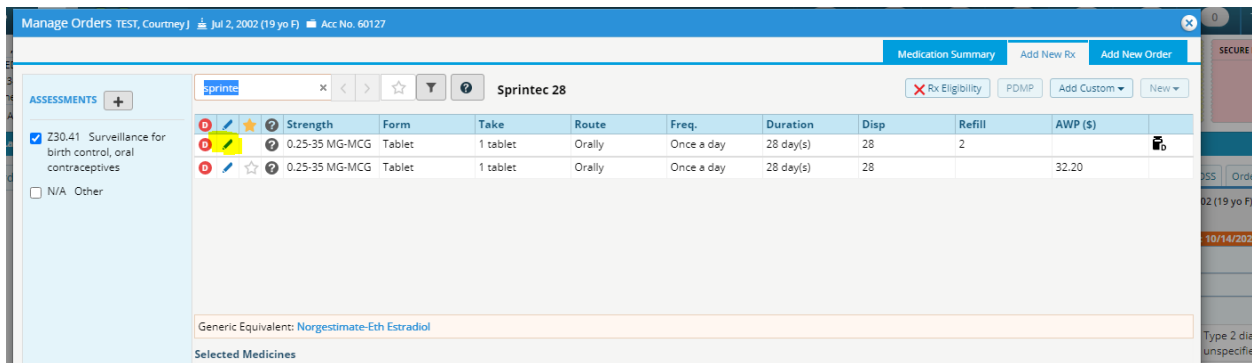


HOW TO- Dispensing Birth Control from KTCH Stock

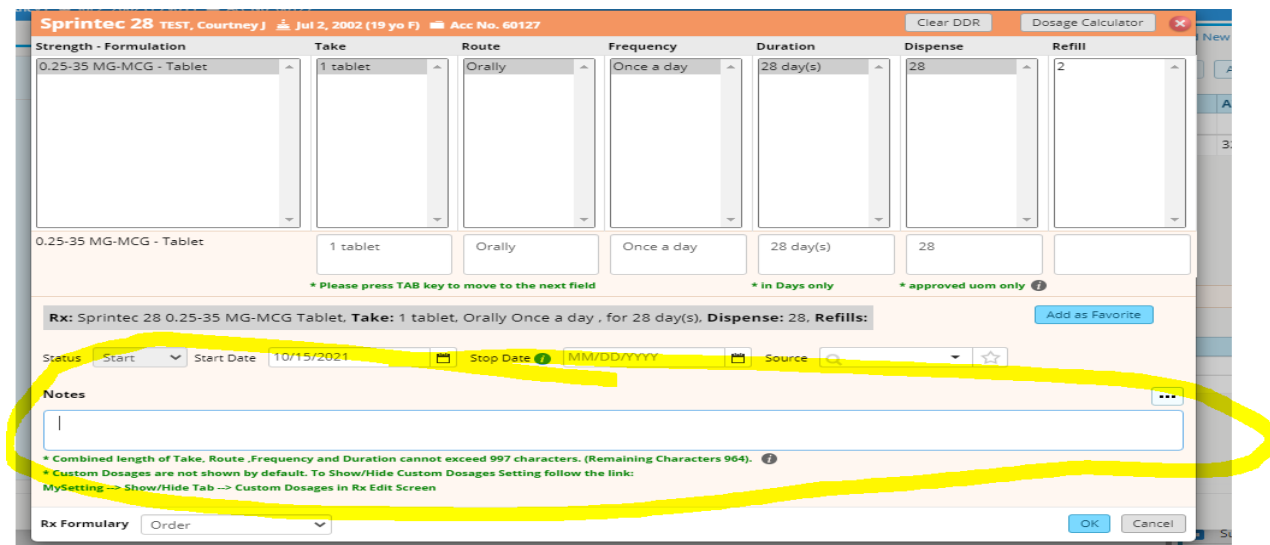
1. Medication is ordered Treatment > RX > Search desired medication



2. Select the pencil to edit medication




3. Once in the edit screen, in the notes box the number of samples, lot number, and expiration date from medication being dispensed should be entered in here.

4. TIP- If you click the ellipse above the note box on the right side, there is a preset template to enter amount given, lot number and expiration date.
